




Innovation

 $KE = 0.5 \times \text{mass} \times \text{velocity squared}$



Textiles Year 10



Year 8 have been learning how to make bread and have then made pizzas using their homemade dough.




Year 10 Food Technology




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


House points

Chadwick continue to lead the house points competition. Mercia are close behind, can they work hard this week to close the gap?








CAREERS
